

Peace House Institute of Vocational Training (PIVoT) **Admission into the Training Programmes**

Peace House Institute of Vocational Training (PIVoT) is an incorporated training arm and a member of the Living Seed Team (Peace House) Inc., Gboko Benue State, Nigeria.

After many years of ministering, a growing necessity to provide different levels of training to further the preaching of Christ's Gospel became a task waiting for an urgent attention. Upon this, Peace House under the leadership of Brother Gbile Akanni and through prayers commenced specialized trainings in various aspects of ministry endeavors. Among these training programmes are:

- Calvary Arrows College (CAC)
- Peculiar Treasure (Nursery & Primary School)
- Periodic Refresher Training for Teachers (PERTS)

- Peace House Research, Innovation and Center of Excellence (PRICE)
- Peace House Institute of Vocational Training (PIVoT)

God has commanded us to stop weeping over the decay in our society and raise replacement sons and daughters with the new species of life that He will use to heal our society. It is in response to this that we are offering training programmes for various segments of our society.

The focus of PIVoT will ***therefore be in two broad directions. Within a specified period of time, students will receive deliberate training targeted at...***

- ✓ Christ life and character development.
- ✓ Mastery of different aspects of Vocational Training.

A. PROGRAMMES AVAILABLE AND DURATION

It is a two-year (twenty-four months) programme with full-boarding facilities to expose young persons, who are eager to be disciplined in Christ Life and trained in their chosen vocation.

1. TRAINING IN FASHION DESIGN & CLOTHING TECHNOLOGY

This Department will concentrate on producing the specialized skilled hands for the Textile field that is solely responsible for generating fabric materials for the vast fashion design industry, carpet manufacturing and any other cloth-related field. Clothing, carpets, drapes, towels, and rugs will be some of the functional products that will result from this Department. The students shall be exposed to vast theoretical and practical experiences in manipulating all available fabrics to meet the society needs for all manner of clothing both traditional and contemporary; casual, ceremonial, uniforms and corporate attires for male, female, children and even babies. Other aspect of the training shall include leather works, knitting and bits making.

2. TRAINING IN HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT

This Department shall train students on how to produce Nigeria and international dishes, both local and exotic food commodities, organize accommodation and hospitality organizations, supervise Restaurants and Bar operations in hospitality organizations and Event Planning/Management.

They shall also develop the knowledge and understanding of all food commodities in terms of quality, cost, usage and service and control system that will enable them to run their trade profitably. This is done with a goal of self- sustenance, generate revenue and the enhancement of national development.

3. TRAINING IN FINE ARTS & INDUSTRIAL DESIGN

This Department shall train men and women on how to respond to Society's needs by an inspiration to design and innovate. It shall make students into Artist and Designers who analyze society's needs and create solutions that shape how their world looks and functions. Our Industrial Design Department shall prepare them to create objects and services that are functional, inform, entertain, educate and work towards improving people's health and well-being.

They shall know how to communicate ideas and information in materials as diverse as leather, metal, wood and colors etc.

B ENTRY QUALIFICATION AND GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. An Applicant shall be:
 - (a) Born again with a clear evidence of New Birth experience and prepared to work and grow in a Christian environment.
 - (b) Interested in growing the Life of Christ through discipleship.
 - (c) Able to communicate and write in English Language.
 - (d) Must be willing to maintain a life of discipline through hard work
2. For all the **Training Programmes**, an applicant must possess a minimum of WAEC, SSCE, NECO or GCE O' Level Certificate (or its equivalence) with five (5) passes including English and Mathematics. Three (3) of the five Subjects must be Credit.
3. Other candidates who possess higher qualifications other than the ones mentioned in 2 above can apply. These may include but not limited to candidates who possess OND, NCE, HND and or B.Sc in any discipline.

C OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1.
 - (a) All applications shall be made by filling of forms.
 - (b) An application shall be deemed successful after a formal interview and a written offer of admission.
2. A successful applicant shall provide two Referees (including parent) and a Guarantor (not parent) who shall be a deeply committed Christian in good standing in his immediate community.

3. A trainee shall be **provided hostel type accommodation with feeding, but he/she shall be encouraged to give towards feeding as he/she has ability to so do. No trainee shall be allowed to stay off campus.**
4. The programmes are tuition free as such **No Fees** of any kind shall be collected from any trainee under any arrangement throughout the entire period of training.
5. The Institute, shall not pay **any allowance or remuneration** to any trainee during the period of training.
6. The training programmes shall be 24 months full time after which he/she shall be released for 12 months internship in an environment that is suitable for his/her discipleship making.
7. When a circumstance is beyond the trainee's control to complete his training, he shall give a **three months notification of withdrawal** except in the case of an emergency.
8. Admitted candidates shall go through a matriculation process before the commencement of their training.
9. All successful trainees will be **released from training in a convocation ceremony by prayer and impartation** in addition to the award of appropriate certificates, which will be awarded by PIVoT authorities.
10. In the event of gross misconduct, theft, indiscipline, immorality, fighting by a trainee, the management may terminate the training without prior formal notice. The trainee in case of theft or damage may also be required to return or replace such items.

D. **PROGRAM CONTENT AND OUTLAY**

- (i) **To achieve the objective of Christ life and character development, all trainees, irrespective of course, shall;**
 - a) Participate in regular and compulsory devotion, Bible studies, Retreats, discipleship training programmes, etc;
 - b) Belong to and be involved in Floor Group activities and discussions;
 - c) Be attached to and submit in a personal relationship with a Vocational Discippler.
- (ii) **To achieve the objective of training in our Vocational Institute and award of our Certificate, the trainee shall be required to learn and work in the various aspects of the Institute related to their course of study. These shall be done through**
 - a) Attend online and onsite lectures which will form 30 percent of his/her assessment
 - b) Attend practical sessions in their field of studies;

Other requirements for the award of our certificate in any of the areas listed above include

- Student's independent seminar paper presentation
- Student's independent final year research project
- One or two months of Industrial Training outside PIVoT
